(2) The Board shall appoint a Secretary to the Authority on such terms and conditions as it may determine.

(3) The Secretary shall, under the general supervision of the Director-General, carry out corporate secretarial duties for the Board and perform such other functions of the Authority as may be assigned to the Secretary by the Director-General.

(4) The Director-General may appoint, on such terms and conditions as the Board may determine, such other staff as are considered necessary for the performance of the functions of the Authority.
